Constructing on abandoned surface mines or over abandoned underground mines may cause building and infrastructure problems for Ohio landowners. Problems such as settling, landslides or encountering mine gases can lead to expensive repairs or become public safety hazards.

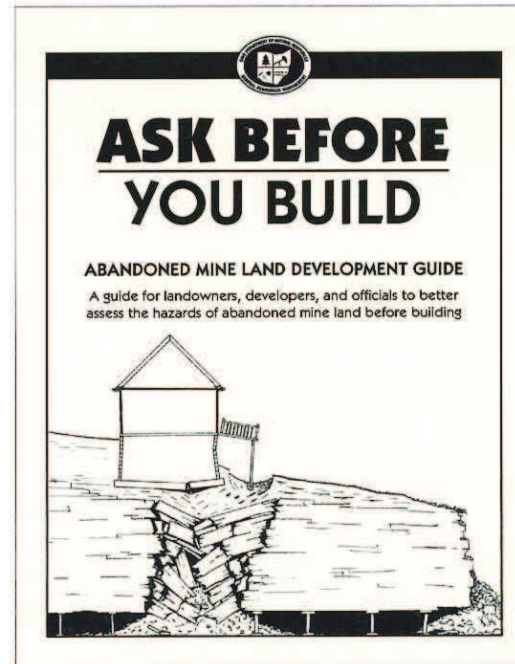


Abandoned Underground Mine Locator

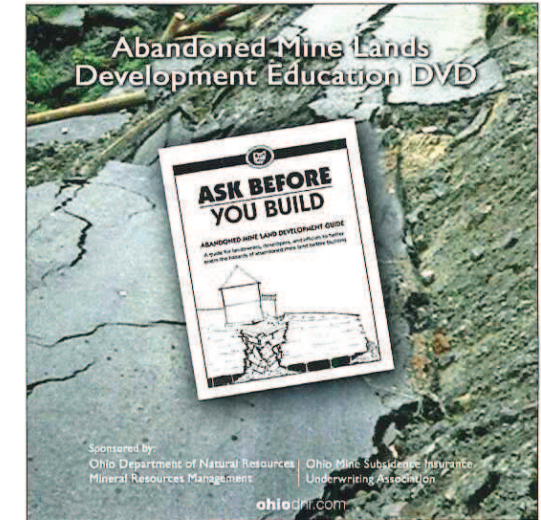
